Significant Events

Innovation & Efficiency Implementation: In 2012 the Phoenix Fire Department, implemented 50 recommendations for changes in management and operations from the Innovation and Efficiency study prepared by Management Partners, Inc.

Fire Ground Survival Training: The Fire Department took almost a year to train all sworn members in behaviors to prevent fire ground emergencies as well as how to react if faced with a life-threatening event.

Safer Grant: The Phoenix Fire Department accepted a SAFER Grant for 28 firefighter positions. The grant covered all costs for two years without any matching funds.
