- Reservations may be made for: Havasupai, Yavapai and Pima 1&2 ramadas.
- All other Ramadas and picnic areas are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Fees are flat rate, per reservation.
- Reservation times between are 8:00 a.m.–6:00 p.m.
- Maximum Capacities for ramadas and other picnic areas will be strictly enforced.
- PARKING IS FOR ALL PARK USERS AND IS NOT GUARANTEED; PARKING MAY BE LIMITED.
- BEER permits cost \$28 and are for BEER ONLY.
- ABSOLUTELY NO: glass bottles, dunk tanks, piñatas, confetti, bounce houses and inflatables, or amplified music/sound (PA Systems, music, microphones, etc) are allowed in the desert parks and preserves.

North Mountain Park has several areas that can be reserved:
 Havasupai Ramada (150)
 Yavapai Ramada (100)
 Pima Area (50)
 This area also boasts a children's playground.

Nine ramada areas available on a first-come, first served basis. The two smaller areas can accommodate 10 people, the largest non-reservable area, the Piute Ramada, can accommodate up to 100 people. Fee: None.

With a ramada reservation, beer permits are available for \$28. Reservations can be made no more than six months in advance with no more than one per day, per ramada. No more than 3 reservations in any 3 month period allowed per person or group.

Amplified music or sound is not allowed. No moon walks (inflatable jumpers), dunk tanks or piñatas allowed. Reservation hours are from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Restrooms are locked daily at 7 p.m.

Silent Sunday is held on the second Sunday of each month. On these days, the park's main roadways are closed to motor vehicles, and park use is limited to non-motorized activities for the entire day.
