



2 players Ages 5+

Game set-up

To save paper, don't print the instructions. Instead, print only the cards by printing pages 2-9 double-sided. Cut out the cards (with adult supervision) and shuffle them.

Game play

- 1. The objective of the game is to collect the most pairs of cards.
- 2. Shuffle the cards and lay them on the table, face down, in rows of four.
- 3. The youngest player goes first. Play then continues in a clockwise direction.
- 4. On each turn, a player turns over any two cards (one at a time) and keeps them if the cards match (for instance, two kings)
- 5. If they successfully match a pair, they get to keep the cards, and that player gets another turn.
- 6. When a player turns over two cards that do not match, those cards are turned face down again (in the same position) and it becomes the next player's turn.
- 7. The trick is to remember which cards are where.
- 8. The person with the most pairs at the end of the game wins.

Hint - When you are done with your game, and no longer want the cards, recycle them!
