

## Neighborhood Notification: Bicycle Improvements on Encanto Boulevard, 31st Avenue to 27th Avenue

As part of the Street Transportation Department's core mission, we strive to improve the City's roadways to create a safe and efficient transportation network. Our ongoing pavement maintenance program provides opportunities to change the current traffic lane striping to improve safety for people who walk, drive, ride bicycles and use transit.

## **About the Project**

Where: Encanto Boulevard from 31st Avenue to 27th Avenue

**What:** Where there is enough space on the roadway, bicycle lanes will be added. The number of travel lanes will remain the same. This project does not remove or add parking.

**When:** Pavement maintenance (new asphalt) is planned for spring 2021 and traffic lane improvements will happen shortly after.

**Why:** The bicycle lanes add dedicated space for people riding bicycles and make it easier for motorists to see them. Additionally, the slight narrowing of the lane widths to accommodate the bicycle lanes will help to guide cars and deter speeding. The proposed bicycle lanes also provide connectivity between nearby bicycle lanes.
