

PROJECT UPDATE – September 2023 Osborn Road from 19th Avenue to 11th Avenue

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while it considered proposed changes to the section of Osborn Road from 19th Avenue to 11th Avenue.

In March 2023, the department hosted a live virtual public meeting to discuss four potential options with the community. An online survey was available for two weeks after the meeting to gather additional feedback. The input gathered from that outreach effort and engineering judgement were taken into consideration as department staff selected the final design.

PROJECT DETAILS

- There were four options presented for this corridor. Option A was to make no changes. Option B was for bike lanes and three driving lanes (two westbound). Option C was for bike lanes, one driving lane in either direction and a two-way center turn lane. Option D was for protected bike lanes and one driving lane in either direction.

DECISION

- Option D was selected – protected bike lanes, with one driving lane in either direction. The left turn lanes at the Osborn Road intersections at 19th Avenue and 15th Avenue will not be removed.

WHAT'S NEXT

- The new lane configuration will be striped after a pavement maintenance project that is scheduled for October 2023. The vertical delineators for the protected bike lanes will be installed following completion of the striping.
