

Neighborhood Notification: Bicycle Improvements on Rose Garden Lane from 32nd Street to Cave Creek Road

As part of the Street Transportation Department's core mission, we strive to improve the City's roadways to create a safe and efficient transportation network. Our ongoing pavement maintenance program provides opportunities to change the current traffic lane striping to improve safety for people who walk, drive, ride bicycles and use transit.

About the Project

Where: Rose Garden Lane from 32nd Street to Cave Creek Road.

What: Where there is enough space on the roadway, new edge lines will be added. The number of travel lanes will remain the same. This project does not remove or add parking.

When: Pavement maintenance (new asphalt) is scheduled for Fall 2022 and traffic lane improvements will happen shortly after.

Why: The slight narrowing of the lane widths to accommodate the new edge lines will help to guide cars and deter speeding.




West of 28th St to 32nd St
