Central City Precinct Mourns the Loss of Our Brave Brother

It is with a heavy heart that the Phoenix Police Department received the news of the tragic death of Officer Thomas Rabjohn while serving his country in Afghanistan. The Phoenix Police Department has answered our nations call over 107 times since September 11, 2001. Tom's selfless sacrifice on behalf of the men and women of the United States has enshrined him in the Canon of Heroes. Officer Rabjohn's end of watch was Saturday October 3, 2009. May he forever rest in peace.

Officer Rabjohn has been a member of the Phoenix Police Department since September 30, 2002. He was currently assigned to the Central City Precinct.

SSgt Rabjohn was assigned to the Arizona Army National Guard's Coolidge -based 363RD Ordnance Company (Explosive Ordnance Disposal). The 363RD's primary mission is to eliminate explosive hazards in assigned areas and provide ordnance disposal support for Operation Enduring Freedom. They deployed to Fort Lewis, WA for training and then deployed to Afghanistan in April.

Officer Rabjohn is survived by his wife Nikki, daughters Kylee (14), Koree (13) and Kelsee (12). Funeral service details will be provided as soon as they become available.

An Account has been established at Wells Fargo in the name of Thomas Rabjohn for those wishing to make contributions to his family. Donations are being accepted at any branch.
