1 Applicant: **Arizona State University Dance Dept.**

 Project Title: D.A.R.T. (Dance Arizona Repertory Theatre)

 Council District(s): 8

 Project Description: Support to continue and expand ASU Dance Department's on-going four-year partnership with the Herrera School for the Arts. D.A.R.T. (Dance Arizona Repertory Theatre), a pre-professional company for graduate and undergraduate students, aims to train dance majors in the preparation and presentation of lecture-demonstrations and master classes. To this end, D.A.R.T. will offer workshops that take students through warm-up activities, exploration of movement and space and creation of new dance works culminating in a showcase at the Third Street Theatre, a venue more accessible to friends and family.

 Amount Recommended: \$3,600

2 Applicant: **Arizona State University Herberger College of Fine Arts**

 Project Title: Village Drumming For Positive Group Affiliation

 Council District(s): 7

 Project Description: Support for a project that will introduce drumming to address gang prevention for at-risk youth based on active participation in group drumming experiences and other supportive arts activities.

 Amount Recommended: \$4,050

3 Applicant: **AZ Chapter - American Orff-Schulwerk Assn**

 Project Title: Teacher Training Workshops

 Council District(s): 1-8

 Project Description: Support to provide professional development for music educators in the philosophy and process of Orff-Schulwerk, an interrelated music, movement and speech concept created by Carl Orff.

 Amount Recommended: \$834

4 Applicant: **Childsplay, Inc.**

 Project Title: Partnership with Isaac Elementary District

 Council District(s): 1-8

 Project Description: Support for Childsplay artists to work in all eight elementary schools in the Isaac School District, leading teacher-training workshops to show educators how to use theatre as a teaching tool in the classroom; giving performance of the plays "Rhubarb Jam" and "Wiley and the Hairy Man" and supporting performances with materials that will show how to integrate the theatre experiences into the classroom and how to use the experience and those lessons to develop the skills and knowledge described in the Arizona Arts Standards.

 Amount Recommended: \$6,000

5 Applicant: **Free Arts of Arizona**
Project Title: Treasure Hunt at Thomas J. Pappas School
Council District(s): 8
Project Description: Support for a program that will direct the exploration of the environment within and outside the Thomas Pappas School for homeless children helping them to safely discover the spirit of community. The treasure hunt program will teach children to see the "treasures" of their every day world through the exploration of many types of artistic media, including drawing, journaling and photography.
Amount Recommended: \$2,127

6 Applicant: **Phoenix Symphony Association**
Project Title: Classroom Concert Series in Phoenix
Council District(s): 1-8
Project Description: Support for five Classroom Concerts in Phoenix Schools during 2001-02 season. The program is designed to provide students K-8 with an introduction to classical music, bringing the Sinfonietta (the string players of The Phoenix Symphony) to schools for two interactive concerts.
Amount Recommended: \$3,900

7 Applicant: **Phoenix Theatre**
Project Title: Young Theatregoers Impact Project
Council District(s): 1-8
Project Description: Support to improve the study guides for Phoenix Theatre's Cookie Co. and encourage their use by teachers prior to a field trip program called Young Theatregoers which provides children the opportunity to see a professional theatre production in a "working theatre" setting. The expanded program will also include sending an artist/trainer to the classroom pre or post production to demonstrate the usefulness of the study guide in addressing the Arizona Arts Standards and improving the quality of the theatre experience for children and teachers.
Amount Recommended: \$2,943

8 Applicant: **Showcase Concerts**
Project Title: An OperaTunity for the Osborn School District
Council District(s): 4
Project Description: Support for OperaTunity to provide a fully-staged opera for children in the Osborn School District, familiarizing them with classical music and opera as an artform. This project would give students a chance to see how all of the elements of opera come together into a fully staged, and costumed production of Mozart's opera, The Magic Flute. Students will have an opportunity to participate with the singers in music and drama, learning basic techniques of singing and stage movement.
Amount Recommended: \$1,734

Applicant: **Southwest Human Development Inc.**

Project Title: Arizona Wolf Trap Program

Council District(s): 4,5,6,7,8

Project Description: Support for the Wolf Trap Institute for Early Learning Through the Arts to enhance the Head Start curriculum. The program has four components: classroom instructional programs where professional artists conduct sessions with children, training workshops for both teachers and parents to introduce the advantage of performing arts activities in teaching social, emotional, physical and cognitive skills; field trips where professional dancers and jazz musicians perform for Head Start children and their families; and instructional materials, a compilation of drama, music and movement activities with audio cassette tapes and an English/Spanish handbook for parents titled ArtsPlay.

Amount Recommended: \$5,000

Applicant: **Theater Works**

Project Title: Books Alive (2002)

Council District(s): 4

Project Description: Support for the Books Alive program that will be traveling to the Cartwright School District in Phoenix. Through this theatrical literacy program, students discover universal concepts, develop a broad world view and gain the ability to identify conflict in dramatic performance. The project is offered free of charge to students and teachers and provides a book for each child involved in the program. The season includes productions of "The Legend of Sleepy Hollow," "The Lion and The Witch and the Wardrobe" and "Little Women."

Amount Recommended: \$3,900
