1 Applicant: **Arizona Opera**

 Project Title: Opera Briefs In-School Tour

 Council District(s): 4

 Project Description: The Opera Briefs In-School Tour for 2004-2005 will feature Opera Soup, an interactive program that features a variety of opera scenes, three to eight minutes in length, sung in the original languages. Children are asked to participate and study guides are circulated prior to the performances for students and teachers. The guides contain information on composers, terminology, activities, and other educational information.

 Amount Recommended: \$3,500

2 Applicant: **Arizona State University Dance Dept.**

 Project Title: Expanding Boundaries

 Council District(s): 8

 Project Description: Support for D.A.R.T. (Dance Arizona Repertory Theatre), a continued partnership with the after-school programs at Sylvestre Herrera Jr. High School and the Thomas J. Pappas School for homeless and migrant children. Students will be given exposure to local and national guest artists, workshops and performances, learn life skills that build confidence and leadership and develop an understanding for collaboration and cooperation.

 Amount Recommended: \$4,250

3 Applicant: **ASU Public Events**

 Project Title: Kaleidoscope '05

 Council District(s): 2

 Project Description: Support for Kaleidoscope, ASU Public Event's educational program that recognizes, encourages and motivates students who might not otherwise, by choice or circumstance, have an opportunity to experience live theatre. In 2005, the Broadway production of "Lion King" will afford the students the opportunity to learn about the historical and cultural aspects of Africa. Teacher coordinators will conduct a ten-week unit based on the play that connects to social studies, history, science and math.

 Amount Recommended: \$2,100

4 Applicant: **Ballet Arizona**
Project Title: Class Act '05
Council District(s): 4
Project Description: Support for "Class Act" the Ballet's educational outreach program that gives children the opportunity to choreograph their own piece, work on lighting, music selection and costume design for their public performance. Students from Montecito Community School in Phoenix learn basic movement techniques and work collectively to choreograph a unique production. The final production called "Ballet Under The Stars" is presented outdoors at a park located near the participating schools.
Amount Recommended: \$3,000

5 Applicant: **Childsplay, Inc.**
Project Title: Theatre Residency Project
Council District(s): 1-8
Project Description: Support for a a year-long residency program at Roadrunner Elementary and Andalucia Middle Schools. The primary goal of the project is to develop in Childsplay's partner schools a core group of educators who possess the knowledge and skills to implement theatre activities across a variety of disciplines.
Amount Recommended: \$4,500

6 Applicant: **Free Arts of Arizona**
Project Title: On Your Toes! '05
Council District(s): 1-8
Project Description: Support for "On Your Toes," a program with dancer, Andrew Needhammer of Ballet Arizona, teaching a series of ballet classes to three second-grade classes during the school year. Each class will have twenty 30-minute instructional sessions followed by a performance at a school function. A special enhancement to the program is a field trip to Ballet Arizona Studio where students observe a company class. Students also receive tickets to attend Ballet Arizona's performance of The Nutcracker.
Amount Recommended: \$3,300

7 Applicant: **Great Arizona Puppet Theater**
Project Title: Reach Out With Puppets
Council District(s): 8
Project Description: Support for the Great Arizona Puppet Theatre's educational outreach program that provides tickets to any "Head Start Specific" schools. Accompanying study guides will be provided to each participating classroom along with student activity sheets. Students, teachers and parents will be served by this program.
Amount Recommended: \$4,000

8 Applicant: **Phoenix Bach Choir**
Project Title: Bach To School Outreach Program
Council District(s): 4-8
Project Description: Support for Phoenix Bach Choir's educational outreach program, "Bach To School", consisting of educational materials disbursed to participating schools prior to each program. These materials called a "Bach-pak" include information about the Choir, the repertoire that students will hear, historical background of choral singing, basic physiological information about voice and the production of sound plus fun, informative and innovative puzzles and quizzes.
Amount Recommended: \$1,900

9 Applicant: **Phoenix Boys Choir Association**
Project Title: PBC-Neighborhood Choirs Program
Council District(s): 4
Project Description: Support for Phoenix Boys Choir's outreach efforts to encourage multiple training choirs in schools throughout the Valley. In a systematic, sequential manner, the PBC will partner with selected school districts to expand the number of boys who will be given the opportunity provided by the education and training traditionally done only at the Choir's home facility.
Amount Recommended: \$3,500

10 Applicant: **Phoenix Symphony Association**
Project Title: Symphony For The Schools
Council District(s): 8
Project Description: Support for four "Symphony in the Schools Programs" in collaboration with the Phoenix Elementary School District No. 1, to assist in engaging Title One school students to participate in four concerts next season. The project will enhance learning skills, communication skills, creativity, teamwork, discipline and cultural awareness.
Amount Recommended: \$3,688

11 Applicant: **Phoenix Theatre**
Project Title: New Perspective-Enriching Classrooms
Council District(s): 8
Project Description: Support for in-service workshops during the 2004-2005 school year available to all school districts in Phoenix, concentrating on those with limited resources. The workshops will be aimed at conducting theatre activities with the teachers grades K-8, which they can then take into their classrooms and utilize to enliven their core curriculum while meeting the Arizona Art Standards.
Amount Recommended: \$2,020

12 Applicant: **Rosie's House: A Music Academy for Children**

Project Title: Music Mexicano

Council District(s): 8

Project Description: Support for monthly music lessons on the specialized music performed by a Mariachi group and instructed by a musician of Hispanic culture. Group lessons will be held every Thursday evening after school and target children who reside in low-income and high-risk communities.

Amount Recommended: \$1,914

13 Applicant: **Sun Cities Chamber Music Society**

Project Title: School Chamber Music Programs

Council District(s): 1-8

Project Description: Support for Sun Cities Chamber Music Society's educational outreach program including six concert series of performances of chamber music. Prior to the programs, the Society provides the schools information concerning the artists, information about the concert and sample tapes to help prepare students for the experience.
