1 Applicant: **Arizona Alliance for Arts Education**

 Project Title: Early Childhood Arts Partnership

 Council District(s): 1-8

 Project Description: Support for the Alliance's Early Childhood Arts Partnership program that focuses on arts-based professional development for teachers in early childhood education. All in-services will be provided in Phoenix to increase confidence and competence in arts education, including the topic areas: arts in the classroom, arts standards, and focused breakout sessions in movement, drama, visual arts and music.

 Amount Recommended: \$2,750

2 Applicant: **Arizona Opera**

 Project Title: Opera School Tour

 Council District(s): 1-8

 Project Description: Support for the School Tour for 2006-2007 presenting Gian Carlo Menotti's opera The Old Maid and the Thief to students in middle and high schools. Professional study guides will be circulated prior to the performances for students and teachers and are written to follow the guidelines of the Arizona Arts Standards.

 Amount Recommended: \$3,000

3 Applicant: **Arizona State University Dance Dept.**

 Project Title: Integrating Communities - A Mixed Ability Dance Project

 Council District(s): 8

 Project Description: Support for commissioning AZIS, an internationally recognized mixed ability dance company based in San Francisco to teach two week-long residencies during the 2006-07 school year. These residencies will focus on uniting three distinct communities: 7th and 8th graders from Sylvestre Herrera School, DART university students and members of the disabled community.

 Amount Recommended: \$4,250

4 Applicant: **Arizona Theatre Company**

 Project Title: Student Matinee Series Expansion

 Council District(s): 8

 Project Description: Support for a project to enrich the educational experience of high school students in central Phoenix by introducing them to theatre, its playwrights and its thematic material while challenging them to think and critically analyze the play, production and performances.

 Amount Recommended: \$3,750

5 Applicant: **Bead Museum**
Project Title: Rites of Passage School Residencies
Council District(s): 4
Project Description: Support for a series of four school visits, targeting approximately 200 students in grade 7, to include artists' visits, art-making activities, storytelling, drum/music demonstration plus discussion of a personal "coming of age" experience. Created in collaboration with Osborn Middle School teachers, the residency will include an arts education lesson unit in adherence with the Arizona Arts Education standards.
Amount Recommended: \$1,640

6 Applicant: **Childsplay, Inc.**
Project Title: Theatre Residency Project '07
Council District(s): 5
Project Description: Support for a new model of school residencies for Childsplay, one that places emphasis on teacher training as well as theatre experiences for students. The following activities are scheduled throughout the year: teacher in-services, classroom workshops, Childsplay performances and testing the most effective strategies for future use with their partner schools.
Amount Recommended: \$4,750

7 Applicant: **Educational Care Inc. {Copper Sun Child Develop Ctr}**
Project Title: The Art of Growing
Council District(s): 8
Project Description: Funding for the proposed "Art of Growing" project using art to bring the natural world into the Copper Sun Child Development Center's main gathering areas. Professional artist Joan Waters will work in tandem with the directors and educators of Copper Sun to develop lesson plans and activities that result in a brilliant, colorful mural painted on two large walls of the Community Rooms.
Amount Recommended: \$2,500

8 Applicant: **Florence Crittenton Services of Arizona**
Project Title: Hip Hop Dancing
Council District(s): 4
Project Description: Support for Nebellen's dance instructors to teach dance movements, rhythm and an understanding of emotional expression through body movement in Crittenton Youth Academy. Girls will emulate dance steps and be encouraged to create their own movements individually and as teams.
Amount Recommended: \$1,820

9 Applicant: **Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation**
Project Title: Design Your Own Dream Space
Council District(s): 7
Project Description: Proposed partnership with Wilson Elementary School for a nine-week "Design Your Own Dream Space" project offered to 4-6th graders. The project includes a combination of theory and philosophy with the hands-on manipulation of materials and encourages students to incorporate architectural principles as they design and construct their own creative models.
Amount Recommended: \$3,106

10 Applicant: **Heard Museum**
Project Title: Heard Museum Teacher Institute
Council District(s): 7
Project Description: Support for the Heard's annual Teacher Institute during the summer at its main campus in Phoenix. The five-day intensive experience is designed to provide educators with the resources they need to effectively teach their students about indigenous cultures.
Amount Recommended: \$2,750

11 Applicant: **Phoenix Conservatory of Music**
Project Title: Early Childhood Professional Development Series
Council District(s): 7
Project Description: Support for early childhood professional development workshops in the Phoenix Elementary School District. Early childhood educators receive training, experience, tools and follow up feedback to implement a music/academic integrated program in their existing core curriculum and meet the new state and national arts standards for the preschool/primary music discipline.
Amount Recommended: \$1,330

12 Applicant: **Southwest Human Development Inc.**
Project Title: Arizona Wolf Trap Program '07
Council District(s): 4-8
Project Description: Support for Arizona Wolf Trap, Early Learning Through the Arts arts-in-education program to improve the effectiveness of early childhood education by training teachers in the use of performing arts as a teaching tool and by using movement and creative drama as teaching strategies to help children master a variety of skills.
Amount Recommended: \$4,500
