### Early and Accessible Voting Sites Special Election May 20, 2008

On Tuesday, May 20, 2008, the City of Phoenix will hold a Special Election for voters to decide a ballot measure.

#### **Early Voting by Mail**

Any eligible voter may cast an early ballot by mail. Request forms to vote early by mail are available at [phoenix.gov](http://phoenix.gov) and at city public service counters and libraries. Request forms also can be obtained by calling the City Clerk Department, Elections Division. The City Clerk Department must **receive** signed written requests for an early ballot by mail no later than 5 p.m. Friday, May 9.

Voters who receive early ballots by mail must mail or deliver them to the City Clerk Department so that they are **received** by 7 p.m. on Election Day, May 20. On Election Day, voters may deliver their early ballots to any city polling place before the polls close at 7 p.m.

#### **Early and Accessible Voting Locations**

Voters may cast an early ballot, or exchange a damaged or spoiled early ballot received by mail, at early voting sites throughout the city until May 16. #### **Accessible Voting Equipment**

Accessible voting devices that permit voters with disabilities to vote independently will be available at the early voting sites and other designated locations.
