Community and Supportive Services Purpose and Criteria

The HOPE VI Community and Supportive Services Program is designed to help the residents of Matthew Henson achieve self-sufficiency and provide community residents with the opportunity to enhance their quality of life. Through partnerships with many community agencies, the program can assist area residents with many social, educational, and employment services to improve their overall general well-being.

Service Categories

➤ **Supportive Services**

(Includes services such as counseling, substance abuse counseling, domestic violence prevention, and emergency assistance)

➤ **Education Services**

(Includes services such as GED classes, English as a Second Language Classes, Adult Basic Education, Computer Education, Technical Schools, and Community College enrollment)

➤ **Employment Services**

(Includes services such as job preparation, Life Skills, job readiness, job referrals and placement, Section 3 job placement, and career advancement)

➤ **Youth Services**

(Services include case management to keep youth successfully in school, youth employment and training, youth leadership, recreational activities, mentoring)

➤ **Home Ownership Services**

(Services include Family Self Sufficiency enrollment, Case management, financial counseling, and homeownership counseling)

➤ **Small Business Services**

(Small business development, business plans, taxes and marketing assistance)

➤ **Community Services**

(HOPE VI newsletter, Block Watch Program, LINKS, Leadership training)
