Notice is hereby given that the RFQ is revised as follows:

1. **Amend Section 2.2, “City’s Consultant Support Team” on page 9, by adding the following firms or individuals to the Consultant Support Team:**

Daniel L. Baggett, P.E.
Greeley and Hansen Architects, LLC
Sonoran Desert Design

2. **Amend Section 2.2, “City’s Consultant Support Team” on page 9, by adding “LLP” to the firm name of Greeley and Hansen.**
3. **Amend Section 2.3, “Selection Committee” on page 10, by replacing the second sentence with the following:**

The Selection Committee consists of six City staff representing the City Auditor, Engineering and Architectural Services, Finance and Water Services Departments and an Arizona licensed contractor from Malcolm Pirnie, Inc.

4. **Amend Section 2.3, “Selection Committee” on page 10, by adding the following new paragraph to the end of the section:**

Respondents are advised that, by virtue of having served on the Selection Committee, MGC Contractors, Inc. is prohibited from being a contractor under the Service Agreement or providing construction, materials or services under the Service Agreement. In no event shall any Respondent include MGC Contractors, Inc. as a member its team or contact MGC Contractors, Inc. during the procurement process concerning any matter relating to this Project. Any failure by a Respondent or its representatives to comply with the foregoing prohibitions may result in a Respondent's disqualification from the procurement process.

5. **Amend Section 3.5.3, "No Stated Dollar Limitation on Liability" on page 22, by adding the following new paragraph to the end thereof as follows:**

The City has received comments from potential Respondents concerning Phoenix City Code Section 42-13.B as it may relate to the City's ability to waive consequential, incidental, special or punitive damages under the Service Agreement. In order to maximize the competition for this Project, the Water Services Department has determined to seek City management's approval for recommending to the Phoenix City Council that the City Council grant a waiver of the City's right to seek the foregoing damages with respect to the Service Agreement if it is found to be in the City's best interests. Respondents are advised, however, that there can be no assurances as to whether the City Council will grant this waiver, or at what point during the procurement process any such waiver may be granted.

- 6. Amend Section 5.1 “General Instructions” on Page 34, by changing the first sentence to read:**

One original and twenty-nine (29) copies of the SOQs must be submitted at or before 2:00 p.m. MST, on Friday, February 9, 2001.

- 7. Amend the last paragraph of Section 5.2 “Information Requirements of Qualifications Submittal” on page 36 by deleting the phrase “number and” from the two bolded sentences.**
