The P.L.A.N. website offers:

- Weekly updates on legislation affecting neighborhoods, City reports and maps, and tips for getting involved
- Access to your state and federal legislators contact information. The P.L.A.N. identifies your State Senator and two Representatives so that you can invite them to a neighborhood meeting. It is important for you to develop a relationship with your legislators.
- An opportunity to voice your opinions on legislative issues. You can call, write or e-mail your legislators from P.L.A.N. to let them know your concerns and how you want them to vote.
- Tools to identify the legislative hearing you want to attend or to testify on a particular bill.

Tours of the State Legislature

Government Relations schedules tours of our state Legislature for Phoenix residents throughout the year. The tour lasts approximately 90 minutes and includes a brief tour of the Arizona Capitol Museum, briefing on the legislative process and tips on how to testify before a legislative committee. 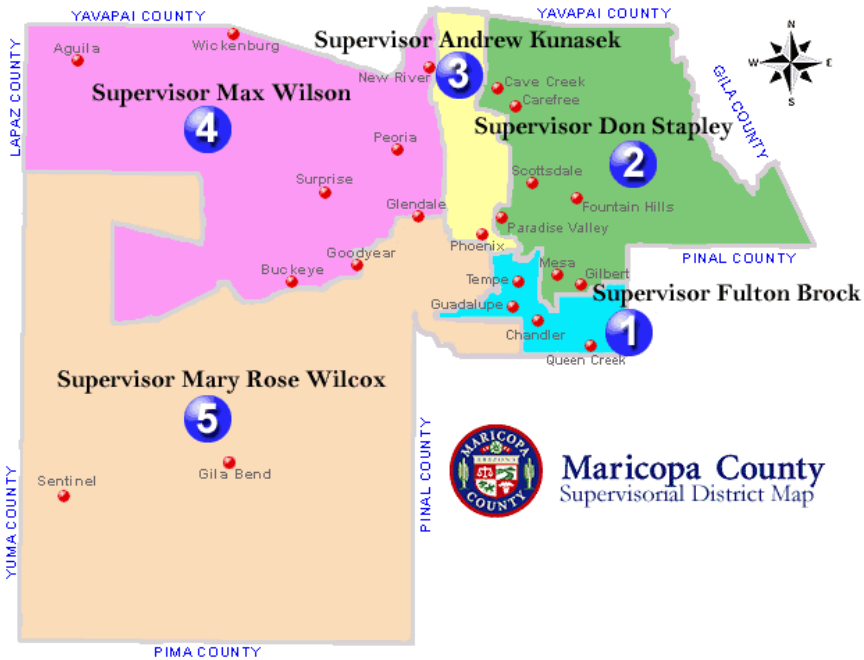
Neighborhood Legislative Workshops

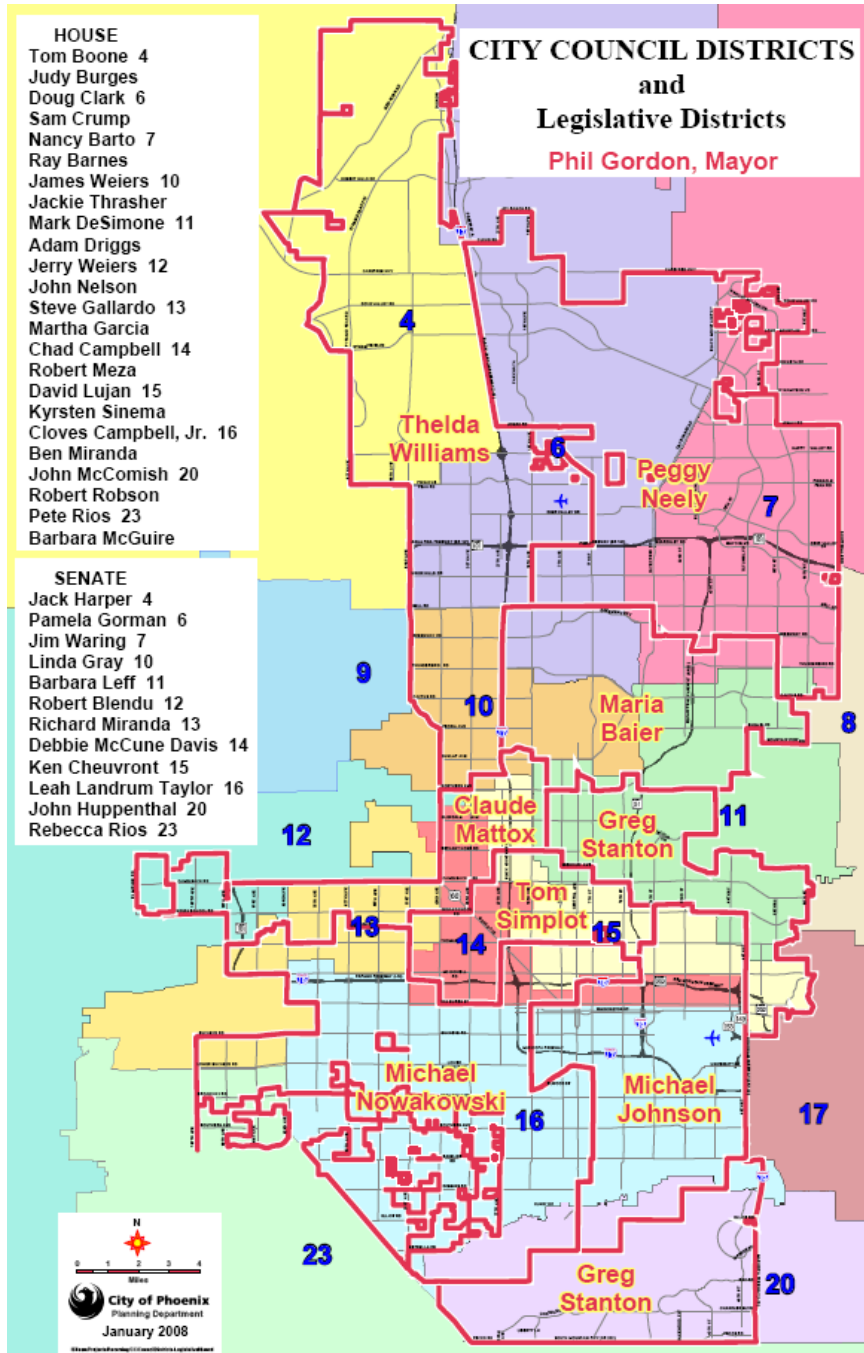
