WHEREAS, a commitment to pollution prevention can increase efficient use of resources in the workplace saving time and money, and

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix has committed resources to implement a Pollution Prevention Program, and

WHEREAS, recognizing Pollution Prevention Week in the City of Phoenix is an opportunity for the City to join forces with business, industry, environmental groups, community organizations and the citizenry at large to work toward a cleaner environment and a more competitive and prosperous business climate.
