EARLY VOTING STARTS SPECIAL COUNCIL ELECTION AND RUNOFF ELECTION NOV. 3, 2009

Early voting for the Nov. 3 City of Phoenix Special Council Election and Runoff Election starts on Oct. 5. In these elections, voters in Council Districts 3 and 6 will elect City Council Members.

The deadline to register to vote in these elections is Monday, Oct. 5.

Early Voting by Mail

Voters in Phoenix Council Districts 3 and 6 who are on the permanent early voting list will be mailed an early ballot unless they have elected not to receive one for this election. Those voters in District 6 who received a ballot by mail for the September 1 Council Election will also receive a ballot by mail for the Runoff Election. Any voters in Districts 3 and 6 who are not on the permanent early voting list may request an early ballot by mail by submitting a signed, written request to the City Clerk Department. Request forms are available at phoenix.gov/ELECTION/d3vvoteidx.html, at city public service counters and libraries, or by calling the City Clerk Department, Elections Division. Early ballot requests must be received by the City Clerk Department no later than 5 p.m. Friday, Oct. 23.

Early Voting Locations and Accessible Voting Equipment

Several early voting sites will be available for voters to cast an early ballot or exchange a damaged or spoiled early ballot received by mail. Any voter may cast an early ballot at any of these locations. Accessible voting devices that permit voters with disabilities to vote independently will also be available at these sites. The list of locations, with the dates and times each are open, can be found in the Sample Ballot Pamphlet, by calling the City Clerk Department at the number below or at phoenix.gov/ELECTION/d3vvoteidx.html.
