Mayo Clinic is pleased to announce a proposal to expand our presence on our Phoenix campus in order to meet the growing demand for medical services throughout Phoenix and the surrounding areas. Since opening in the Valley in 1987, we have gradually increased our presence in both Phoenix and Scottsdale in order to serve our loyal patients. Currently, our Phoenix campus includes Mayo Clinic Hospital, the Mayo Clinic Specialty Building (an outpatient facility), an administrative support building, as well as patient care and support facilities operated by our strategic partners - Hospice of the Valley, Arizona Transplant House and the American Cancer Society.

Our mission is to provide the best care to every patient every day through integrated clinical practice, education and research. The clinical practice is focused on adult specialty and surgical care in more than 65 medical and surgical disciplines, supported by outstanding programs in medical education and research.
