

## City Of Phoenix Contacts

A brief list of City of Phoenix contacts is provided below. These contacts may be helpful when planning your projects. Depending upon the scope of your program, City approvals may be necessary. The time and cost of obtaining necessary approvals should be factored into your proposal. ### **Block Party Permits**

For information about block party permits, call the Streets Department at 602-495-0242.

### **Construction Permits**

Construction projects, including fences and walls, may require permits from the City of Phoenix. To find out if your construction project needs a permit, contact the Development Services Department at one of the following numbers:

### **Signs**

If your group wants to budget funds for Block Watch signs, the Block Watch Advisory Board has prepared an order packet that contains details on the cost of signs and proper placement and mounting. A representative from the Block Watch Advisory Board can be reached at 602-534-2424.

The City of Phoenix has an ordinance prohibiting other types of signs (including A-frame signs) in the right-of-way. The right-of-way includes streets, curbs, medians, street shoulders, and sidewalks. If you have any questions about signs in the right-of-way, call the City of Phoenix Sign Enforcement Removal Hotline at 602-534-7100 or e-mail [illegal.signs.rightofway.nsd@phoenix.gov](mailto:illegal.signs.rightofway.nsd@phoenix.gov). Signs can be placed on private property, but a permit may be required. For information about installing signs on private property, call Development Services at 602-495-0284.

### **Street Lights**

### **Street/Alley/Easement Abandonment**
