Cave Creek Women's Golf Association (CCWGA) is a ladies group of varied ages who enjoy golf and socializing. The City of Phoenix's Cave Creek Golf Course, located at 15202 North 19th Avenue, is the home course and provides a never ending challenge each week for the members. League play is every Wednesday beginning in September and ending in mid-May. Although the league is inactive during the summer, a few ladies endure the heat and continue to play on Wednesday mornings.

CCWGA's annual fee is \$55.00 for new members. This fee includes registration with the Arizona Women's Golf Association, which allows for a handicap to be established and maintained. Individuals are responsible for their weekly green fees and optional cart fee. Cave Creek Golf Course has a full-service pro shop and restaurant on property.

During league play, ladies enjoy a special "play of the day" game (\$3) each week and the option to participate in three member tournaments for competitive fun. All tournaments are flighted, providing for fair competition among different skill levels. In addition, ladies can also choose to take part in team play, Central District tournaments and in the "Hole in One Fund" at a minimal fee. Tee-times are predetermined and emailed to participants weekly. Foursomes are formed by random pairing or sign up methods determined by CCWGA and Pro Shop Staff. Shotgun starts are held several times per year. After every round of golf the ladies congregate in the restaurant to discuss missed "birdies", shots, miraculous putts, and other fun memories of the day.

Anyone interested in playing in the league is invited to join CCWGA for plenty of golf and camaraderie.
