

Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport Impact \$72 Million A Day

Phoenix Sky Harbor's fiscal year 2003 economic activity contributed \$72 million a day to the Phoenix metropolitan economy. On a typical day at Phoenix Sky Harbor 1,300 airliners take off and land, 100,000 passengers pass through the terminals and 788 tons of cargo is handled.

The value added to the Phoenix economy by those persons and businesses that use or supply Phoenix Sky Harbor aviation services was \$6.5 billion in fiscal year 2003. When the multiplier effects of indirect spending are included, the total economic impact was almost \$15.0 billion.
