## Homicide Investigation

On February 14, 2021, at about 12:40 p.m., Phoenix Police responded to a shots-fired call inside a business in the area of 75<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Thomas Road. When officers arrived, they located the two victims inside the shopping center with gunshot wounds. The victims were brought outside to waiting fire personnel and transported to local hospitals. One victim was pronounced deceased at the hospital, the other suffered serious injuries but is expected to survive at this time.

Investigators learned the two victims went to the shopping center and were in an argument over merchandise with an employee at a kiosk. At some point, one of the victims displayed a firearm and then both victims were shot.

The employee at the kiosk is cooperating with investigators. Detectives are still working through evidence and witness statements to determine exactly what happened at this incident. No arrests have been made.
