Fatal Traffic Collision/Hit and Run Investigation

On June 20th, at about 10:05 p.m., Phoenix Police officers responded to a call of a collision near 3500 North 67th Avenue. When officers and firefighters arrived, they located four vehicles that had been involved in the collision.

Investigators learned a GMC pickup was south on 67th Avenue and rear-ended a Jeep Grand Cherokee. The force of that collision caused both vehicles to be pushed into the northbound lanes, where the Jeep collided with a Ford Ranger that was northbound, and the GMC truck collided with a Toyota Camry that was northbound.

The driver of the Jeep left the area on foot prior to police arrival. A total of five people were transported to the hospital. One of the five people, the passenger in the Ford Ranger, was later pronounced deceased. Preliminary information indicates that impairment was a contributing factor to the collision with the driver of the GMC pickup truck.
