Juvenile Struck by Gunfire in Central Phoenix

(December 29, 2022): Detectives are investigating a shooting that sent a juvenile to the hospital in critical condition.

Phoenix Police officers were dispatched to a shooting call in the parking lot of an apartment complex near 17th and Adams Streets. While enroute the caller told 911 operators they left the area and were stopped in the parking lot of a business at 7th Street and Buckeye Road. When officers arrived, they found a male juvenile suffering from a gunshot wound. The fire department responded and rushed the male to the hospital with a life-threatening injury.

Officers found the location of the incident where they found evidence of the shooting. After speaking to witnesses, detectives learned there were multiple shooters while the victim was with a group inside a vehicle.

The victim remains in the hospital in critical condition. No other community members were injured during the shooting. There have been no arrests made and we ask anyone with information to contact the Phoenix Police Department or Silent Witness if they wish to remain anonymous.
