**Victim:** 2-year-old male, hospitalized in stable condition

## **Hit and Run w/ Serious Injury Investigation**

Phoenix, Arizona (February 20, 2022): 2-year-old in stroller struck by a vehicle running a red light; vehicle fled from the scene.

Phoenix Police responded to a traffic collision at 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Glendale Avenue just after 8:20 p.m. When the officers arrived, they learned a 2-year-old male was being pushed in a stroller by a family member in the crosswalk, when a vehicle ran a red light and struck the child. After the collision, the vehicle fled the scene. The Phoenix Fire Department responded and transported the child to a local hospital where he is in stable condition.

The vehicle was described as possibly a 2004-2010 Nissan Altima or Maxima, charcoal gray in color.
