Detectives Investigate a Body Set on Fire in a Dumpster

(March 21, 2023) Phoenix homicide detectives are seeking information about a male victim found inside a dumpster and set on fire Tuesday morning near 11th Avenue and Madison Street.

Phoenix officers responded to a death investigation call at about 7:54 a.m. on March 21, 2023. When officers got to the scene, they saw a male victim inside a dumpster with obvious signs of being burned. The victim was not able to be identified due to the burn injuries covering his body.

Detectives with the Phoenix Police Departments Homicide Bureau responded and took over the investigation. The victim was taken to the Maricopa County Forensic Science Center for examination. This continues to be an active case. Details of the incident will not be known until detectives complete their investigation.
