A Car Pedestrian Collision Leaves Man Dead

(June 27, 2023) Phoenix police detectives are investigating a collision that occurred in the area of 43rd Avenue and Clarendon Avenue leaving a pedestrian dead.

On June 27, 2023, at approximately 1:00 a.m., officers responded to the area of 3800 North 43rd Avenue regarding a collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located an adult male with serious injuries. The man did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased on scene. The vehicle involved, driven by an adult female, remained on scene. Impairment is not believed to be a factor.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the man was crossing midblock on 43rd Avenue just north of Clarendon Avenue when he was struck by the vehicle traveling southbound. Other details about this incident remain part of the ongoing investigation. Detectives are still investigating the scene resulting in 43rd Avenue being shut down in both directions.
