Collision Leaves Pedestrian in Critical Condition

(February 27, 2023) Phoenix police detectives are investigating a serious collision involving a car and a pedestrian that happened early Monday morning just south of Indian School Road on 19th Avenue.

On February 27, 2023, just after 4:00 a.m., Phoenix police responded to 4000 North 19th Avenue regarding a collision involving one vehicle and a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located an adult male pedestrian with serious injuries. The man was transported to a local hospital for treatment and is currently in critical condition. The vehicle involved and the driver of the vehicle remained on scene.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information indicates the pedestrian was eastbound crossing 19th Avenue in a marked crosswalk just north of Fairmount Avenue. He was struck by the vehicle involved in the collision which was traveling southbound on 19th Avenue. The driver of the vehicle was cited and released from the scene.

Specifics about what led up to the collision is part of the ongoing investigation.
