OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

Date/Time: April 1, 2018 at 8:07 a.m.

Location: 2100 North 32nd Street

Officer: 28 year old male, 3 years of service

Suspect: 58 year old male

On April 1, 2018, at 8:07 a.m., Police were dispatched to a residence in the area of 3000 East Monte Vista Drive on a report of a residential burglary. While in route to the call, officers learned the suspect was known to the complainant and was a previous resident of the home. The current residents called police to have an Order of Protection served to the suspect.

When police arrived, they made eye contact with the suspect who then jumped the fence in the backyard and ran from the area. As a perimeter was being established, the suspect was seen running northbound through an apartment complex. The suspect was chased officers. An officer was able to catch the suspect at which time a physical fight ensued. The officer pushed the suspect to create distance and drew his Taser. The suspect pulled a handgun from his waistband and pointed it at the officer. The officer dropped his Taser, and removed his duty weapon and fired at the suspect, striking him and ending the threat. The suspect was taken to the hospital with life-threatening injuries. A handgun was recovered at the scene. There were no injuries to officers.
