OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

On June 14, 2018, at 4:30 a.m., Phoenix police officers were serving a search warrant at a residence located in the area of 2200 West Grove Street. There were complaints of drug activity and drug sales at this residence. Officers approached the residence and suspect(s) inside of the residence began shooting from the within. Two officers were struck by shrapnel and debris from the shots. A diversionary device was used and an officer fired a shot from his rifle.

Gas was also used and the suspect(s) stopped firing at officers. The suspects were ordered out of the home and all suspects complied. Inside the residence officers found weapons and indicia of drug sales.

Two officers received minor injuries from shrapnel and debris, they were treated at scene by fire personnel. The suspects were not injured. During the investigation probable cause was developed by officers to arrest Steve Harris for multiple drug and weapons violations.
