Information Technology Services (ITS) Server Configuration & Patch Management Follow-up

July 2, 2024

The City Auditor Department contracted with BerryDunn, LLC, an external audit firm, to assess the Information Technology Services (ITS) security of server configurations and server patch management practices.

BerryDunn, LLC evaluated the following areas:

- Governance appropriate standards and procedures for configuring and patching servers.
- User access security users are assigned access based on business need, with an emphasis on privileged accounts.
- Configuration parameter settings minimum security standards are implemented across server platforms.
- Security logging and monitoring logs are centrally stored and monitored.
- Remediation of prior audit findings

BerryDunn, LLC identified items for improvement in all audited areas Due to the sensitive nature of the information contained in the report, the details of our report were only shared with department management, City management, and the City Audit Committee.

BerryDunn, LLC was contractually obligated to conduct this performance audit in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards.
