\* The 2012-13 planned levy is at maximum amount allowed which is \$133,929,446. Historically, actual property tax collections are slightly lower than the amount levied. For 2012-13, actual collections for primary property tax are estimated to be \$131,921,000 or 98.5% of the levy amount.
