The meeting started at approximately 5:40 p.m. Implementation Team Co-Chairs, Mr. Julian Nabozny and Mr. Jocquese Blackwell opened the meeting.

Mr. Nabonzy requested a motion for the approval of the February 13, 2011 minutes. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Mr. Reginald Ragland gave a presentation on the role of the recommendation "Champion."

In his presentation Mr. Ragland emphasized the following as traits of a Champion:

- A point **person** who fights for the implementation of strategies to improve relations between COP and community
- Provide leadership/ advocacy for a category
- Share feedback and input on implementation
- Report progress and outcomes during IT meetings
- Encourage involvement of others

Mr. Ragland also explained the key roles of the Cluster Groups as follows:

- Promote community involvement
- Encourage involvement of others
