Neighborhood Parks Enhancement Application Deadline Extension



We are reminding everyone about the Neighborhood Parks Enhancement Program, made possible by the recently voter-approved General Obligation (GO) Bond Program. With \$1.5 million allocated for minor capital improvements, this initiative will ensure that each council district receives dedicated funds to enhance local parks.

The application deadline has been extended to December 2nd for eligible neighborhood organizations to submit project proposals at www.phoenix.gov/neighborhood-parks-enhancement-program. This was done to ensure there is a fair opportunity for more neighborhood groups to apply. Groups may apply for more than one project. Selected projects will be announced with completion scheduled within the GO Bond Program timeframe from 2024 to 2029. Let's work together to enhance our community spaces!
