








Phoenix Summer Safety Operation Totals 5/1/24 - 5/8/24:

- 44 heat related calls for service (Source: Phoenix FD)
- 328 visitors in respite and extended hour cooling centers.
- Overall, 5 and 8pm has seen the highest number of people arriving.
- Walk/Bike has been the most popular method of getting to the cooling center (72%).
- Signs/Flyers have been the most popular method of notification for locating the cooling centers (31%) closely followed by word of mouth (29%).
- **225 visitors (69%)** indicated they are experiencing homelessness.
- **211 visitors (64%)** indicated they just want to get cool and don't need any additional services or referrals.
- **56 referrals** were processed and received direct onsite assistance from CBI.
- 12 referrals self-reported that they were in need of additional follow-up from the City of Phoenix and the Office of Emergency Management initiated those referrals on their behalf.












Patients Transported
