Park Ranger III

Pay Range: \$25.56 - \$37.76 per hour

The Parks and Recreation Department is seeking a Park Ranger III Supervisor for the Natural Resources Division's Urban (neighborhood parks) Park Ranger team. Park Rangers promote behavior that allows everyone to enjoy clean, safe, accessible, and inviting parks and programs. Urban Park Rangers work four, 10-hour shifts.

Park Rangers monitor urban parks, enforce rules and regulations, monitor emergencies, and physically patrol and report issues with parks, swimming areas, parking lots, and park facilities. Park Rangers also communicate with department staff and first responders, issue citations and trespass notices, complete daily patrol logs, and perform general first aid and CPR.
