NALOXONE TRAINING

The Office of Public Health has launched an updated Opioid Overdose Response and Naloxone Training in PHXYou. This course has additional information on stimulant use and impacts associated with heat and



substances. Upon completing the training, employees will be able to identify an opioid overdose and how to use naloxone. Employees who take this training can earn triple cultural competency points. Register on PHXYOU using course code CMO102-ONL-Opioid Overdose and Response.

BURN CLEANER BURN BETTER NATURAL GAS • ELECTRIC • RETROFIT DEVICES

We all know how great a fireplace or outdoor firepit can be on cool winter nights, especially during the holidays. However, during winter, Maricopa County has a problem with smoke accumulating too much at ground level. Recent changes to air quality standards means Maricopa County's current smoke levels will be above the federal health standards. Continuing to burn wood at the current pace will result in a health risk for us all, and the region could face burdensome federal regulations and possible fines.

Please "Burn Cleaner, Burn Better," and on "No Burn" days, don't burn wood, and instead use a gas or electric fireplace or propane firepit. Even better, convert your wood-burning fireplace to natural gas, or retrofit it with an air pollution reduction device. Maricopa County Air Quality Department offers a free fireplace retrofit program and \$75 voucher for a propane firepit. For more information call 602-372-9663 or visit Maricopa.gov/AQ.



Firefighter Recruits attend training for fire suppression, emergency medical treatment, and hazard mitigation work at the Phoenix Fire Department Training Academy for 14-16 weeks of basic recruit training followed by approximately nine months of structured probationary training and evaluation. After successfully completing the Academy, recruits become probationary firefighters.
