Police Aircraft Technicians perform fleet maintenance on helicopters, fixed-wing aircraft, and specialized equipment. The fleet consists of Airbus AS350B3 and Agusta A109e model helicopters and Cessna 172, 182, 210, and Pilatus PC-12 model airplanes. Responsibilities include maintaining helicopter/fixed-wing aircraft and keeping current with industry standards through proactive and ongoing training.
