DID YOU KNOW...


The City of Phoenix offers an Employee Development Fund (EDF) Program for employees to further their education, attend job-related seminars/workshops, and obtain job-related licenses or certifications. The EDF is for all full-time benefit-eligible employees except Middle Managers and Executives (the Management Development Fund is governed by A.R. 2.281 through the Finance Department).
