INSURANCE CONTRACT UPDATE

Phoenix Children's Hospital is no longer in the BCBSAZ Network.



The contract between BCBS and Phoenix Children's Hospital expired on Thursday, Oct. 31, 2024. What to know if you are a BCBS member:

- There are in-network options where you can get the care you need. Find additional details at: <u>www.azbluefacts.com/pch</u>, including maps of alternative in-network hospitals and providers.
- If you have a child that needs ongoing treatment or already had a procedure scheduled after Oct. 30 that had been pre-approved, you may be eligible to receive "Continuity of Care" benefits to complete that care at your current in-network cost share.



Industrial Maintenance Mechanic Water Services Pay Range: \$28.17 to \$41.63 per hour Hiring Range: \$28.17 to \$35.96 per hour

(Pay range is the entire compensation range for the position classification. Hiring range is an estimate of where you can receive an offer.)

Employees in the Industrial Maintenance Mechanic positions are responsible for leading and performing journey-level installation, repair, and maintenance of mechanical equipment such as pumps, blowers, centrifuges, gearboxes, valves, and valve actuators at water or wastewater treatment plants, reclamation plants, groundwater wells, pumping stations, lift stations, and reservoirs. Work assignments are varied, and employees must be skilled in several mechanical trades including fabrication and millwright.

Employees work independently and as part of a team, sometimes leading the team. The successful candidate will be reliable, have a good attitude, and be a team player.


