Vehicle Flees After Hitting and Killing Pedestrian

(July 23, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating an overnight hit and run collision that resulted in the death of a pedestrian.

On July 23, 2024, around 3:10 a.m., officers responded to the area of 19th Avenue and Van Buren Street regarding a collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located the adult male pedestrian with serious injuries. The man was transported to a nearby hospital, but he did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased. The vehicle involved in the collision left the area prior to police arrival.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the vehicle involved was eastbound on Van Buren Street when it collided with the pedestrian and continued eastbound. The vehicle is described as a small sedan with an unknown color. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation. Anyone with information is asked to call Silent Witness at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO) and provide an anonymous tip. Rewards will be paid for information leading to an arrest in this case.
