I. BACKGROUND

Chapter 27 of the Phoenix City Code, the Solid Waste Ordinance, establishes the City's solid waste program, including the general rate structure and customer eligibility.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to document rates related to the collection of solid waste, including rates set by the Director.

III. SCOPE

Policies within the Billing Book apply to City of Phoenix solid waste customers, residents, businesses, non-profit organizations, or government agencies identified within each individual policy and the Solid Waste Ordinance. For further definition of services and qualifications for services see relevant policies.

IV. ANNUAL REVIEW

The below rate structure will be reviewed annually by the Assistant Public Works Director prior to June 30th and/or when needed.

VI. RETIRED FEES AND SERVICES

The following rates or services are no longer available; however, some customers may be considered grandfathered. Any grandfathered customers will no longer be eligible for these rates when the accounts are closed or service to the address is discontinued.

1. Premium Service – Use of a curbside container for an alley customer who does not qualify for Carry-out Service.
2. Non-Participant in Recycling Program (Non-Par) – Customers with two 90-gallon trash containers (prior to 7-1-12), paying for one trash, no recycle container.
