

# Neighborhood Notification: Bicycle Improvements on 15th Avenue from Northern Avenue to Dunlap Avenue

As part of the Street Transportation Department's core mission, we strive to improve the City's roadways to create a safe and efficient transportation network. Our ongoing pavement maintenance program provides opportunities to change the current traffic lane striping to improve safety for people who walk, drive, ride bicycles and use transit.

### **About the Project**

Where: 15th Avenue from Northern Avenue to Dunlap Avenue

**What:** Where there is enough space on the roadway, parking lanes and bike lanes will be added. The number of travel lanes will remain the same and no parking will be removed or added. However the new parking lanes will allow the bike lanes to be available 24/7. The existing traffic calming will not be impacted.

**When:** Pavement maintenance (new asphalt) is upcoming and traffic lane improvements will happen shortly after.

**Why:** Dedicated bike lanes provide space for people bicycling, improving safety and comfort at all times. The slight narrowing of the lane widths to accommodate the parking lane while maintaining the bike lane will help to guide cars and deter speeding.

Butler Dr to Lawrence Ln




Intersection at Butler Dr (looking north)


