## RE: Spring Training MORATORIUM ON ROUTINE MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES (02/23/2024-03/25/2024)

The Spring Training season is fast approaching and with it comes increased traffic on streets near the training centers. Since it is our goal to reduce unnecessary traffic delays and congestion during this time, construction and maintenance activities must be curtailed on major and collector streets near the facilities during this critical period (**February 06, 2025, through March 24, 2025**). The areas where work may be restricted may include, but are not limited to:

## Camelback Ranch Spring Training Moratorium

There will be no lane restrictions approved on game days February 06<sup>TH</sup> through March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025, from 6 a.m. to 1 hour past the end of the game. The end of the game will be considered to begin at the official end of game time or 3 hours past the start of the game, whichever comes first.

Temporary restrictions may be approved for nighttime (nighttime noise ordinance permit may be required) or non-game days. Contact your COP inspector to set up a preconstruction meeting to discuss.

The following streets are part of the moratorium area:

- Camelback Road El Mirage Road to 91<sup>st</sup> Avenue
- El Mirage Road Camelback Road to Bethany Home Road
- 111<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Ball Park Boulevard Campbell Avenue to 99<sup>th</sup> Avenue & Maryland Avenue
- 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue Indian School Road to Rancho Drive
- 99 Avenue Glendale Avenue to Indian School Road
- 91<sup>st</sup> Avenue Indian School Road to Camelback Road



## **Brewers Spring Training Moratorium**

There will be no lane restrictions approved on game days February 22nd thru March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025, from 6 a.m. to 1 hour past the end of the game. The end of the game will be considered to begin at the official end of game time or 3 hours past the start of the game, whichever comes first.

Temporary restrictions may be approved for nighttime (nighttime noise ordinance permit may be required) or non-game days. Contact your COP inspector to set up a preconstruction meeting to discuss.

The following streets are part of the moratorium area:

- Indian School Road 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue
- 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue I-10 to Camelback Road
- 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Indian School Road to 55<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Clarendon Avenue
- Maryvale Parkway 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to Campbell Avenue
- Thomas Road 55<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 48<sup>th</sup> Lane

Although normal construction and maintenance activities in conflict with the training centers will be restricted during this period, emergency repairs will still be allowed. Your cooperation in improving traffic conditions during this moratorium is very much appreciated.
