

PROJECT UPDATE – May 2024

31st Avenue from Bethany Home Road to Glendale Avenue

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while it considered proposed changes to the section of 31st Avenue from Bethany Home Road to Glendale Avenue.

On March 28, 2024, the department hosted an in-person public meeting to discuss proposed options that would narrow the driving lanes and remove some on-street parking to widen bike lanes. To gather additional community input, an online survey was available from March 28 to April 21, 2024.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Two options were presented for this corridor. Option A was to make no change – one driving lane and one bike lane in each direction, and on-street parking on the west side of the roadway. Option B was to narrow the driving lane in each direction and remove the parking lane to allow for widening of the bike lane on both sides of the roadway.

DECISION

- Based on community input, Option B was selected – to narrow the driving lane in each direction and remove the parking lane to allow for widening of the bike lane on both sides of the roadway.

WHAT'S NEXT

- This section of roadway is scheduled for a pavement maintenance project during spring/summer 2024. Roadway striping and signs will be updated and installed after the paving project is completed.
