

PROJECT UPDATE – May 2024 Butler Drive from 7th Street to 12th Street

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while it considered proposed changes to the section of Butler Road from 7th Street to 12th Street.

On March 27 2024, the department hosted a live virtual public meeting to discuss proposed options that would narrow the driving lanes and remove parking to add bike lanes or buffered bike lanes where they do not currently exist. To gather additional community input, an online survey was available from March 27 to April 21, 2024.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Three options were presented for this corridor. Option A was to make no change – one driving lane in each direction and on-street parking on both sides of the roadway. Option B was for one driving lane in each direction, with a bike lane on both sides of the roadway and on-street parking on the north side of the street only. Option C was for one driving lane in each direction, with buffered bike lanes on both sides of the roadway and no on-street parking.

DECISION

- Based on community input, Option A was selected – to make no change.

WHAT'S NEXT

- This section of roadway is scheduled for a pavement maintenance project during spring/summer 2024, and the existing roadway striping will be reinstalled after the paving project is completed.
