

PROJECT UPDATE – May 2024 Campbell Avenue from 67th Avenue to 59th Avenue

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while it considered proposed changes to the section of Campbell Avenue from 67th Avenue to 59th Avenue.

On January 31, 2024, the department hosted a live virtual public meeting to discuss proposed options that would remove on-street parking to add bike lanes or buffered bike lanes where they do not currently exist. To gather additional community input, an online survey was available from January 31 to March 1, 2024.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Three options were presented for this corridor. Option A was to make no change. Option B was to accommodate on-street parking and add bike lanes where they do not currently exist. Option C was to remove on-street parking and add buffered bike lanes.

DECISION

- Based on community input, Option B was selected – accommodate on-street parking and add bike lanes where they do not currently exist. The configuration will vary in different sections of the corridor:
 - 67th Avenue to 65th Drive: One driving lane in each direction, on-street parking on the west side of the roadway, a bike lane on each side of the roadway.
 - 65th Drive to 63rd Avenue: One driving lane in each direction, on-street parking on both sides of the roadway, a bike lane on both sides of the roadway.
 - 63rd Avenue to 59th Avenue: One driving lane in each direction, on-street parking on the east side of the roadway, a bike lane on both sides of the roadway.

WHAT'S NEXT

- This corridor is scheduled for a pavement maintenance project during spring/summer 2024. Roadway striping and signs will be updated and installed after the paving project is completed.
