




## Phoenix Heat and Energy Burden

The Energy Access Plan contributes to increasing the level of energy access, reducing energy poverty within the City of Phoenix, and tracking progress toward these objectives.


#### Energy Access Plan Proposed Goal:

- Increase household participation in low-income energy programs by 20-25% to reduce energy burden within the City of Phoenix by 2030.
  - Baseline: 72,074 households participated in assistance programs in 2024





### **Energy Access Plan Timeline**




